Baskets and Containers

Baskets, tubs and containers are not just a stylistic choice for your photos, they're also a clever way to keep your baby supported in position with concealed blankets and cushions helping to hold the pose that we require. Baskets can be a great option to help 'contain' and hold more alert newborns and if we find that your baby struggles to settle the sensation of being enclosed will often help them to relax.

Your baby's safety and comfort is always the first consideration, so any container that we use will be stuffed with plenty of padding to cover hard surfaces and taller tubs will be weighted at the bottom to keep them stable. Depending on the style and theme of your shoot, baskets can be used as-is, decorated and dressed up or just used as a support to keep baby in position for close-up images.

We can usually manage two or possibly three basket sets during a session before baby gets fed up with being moved about and posed.

See how my 4 most popular baskets are used in different ways and with different backdrops. All of them are extremely versatile and can be set up in a variety of ways to suit your style and to create several different looks from a single pose.

ROUND CENTREPIECE BASKET Shot side on and from above.



bottom right : basket is simply used as a support / posing aid for natural close up shots

CRESCENT BASKET

Used suspended, as a peek through for siblings and as an opportunity for a close up while baby is already posed

SIMPLE WHITE BASKET

Dressed for a variety of different looks



DEEP RUSTIC BASKET

Shot side on, from above and lying on its side on a selection of different sets.
