### Around The Studio

Wern Trading Estate, Rogerstone NP10 9FQ

### Photoshoot Availability

Appointments may be booked around the studio for both mini sessions (20 minutes) and full length (1 hour) photoshoots. Available timings will vary throughout the year depending on natural light conditions.

There are several surprising spots around the studio that are suitable for outdoor photos, but the real hidden gem is an area of grass and trees tucked away behind the entrance to the estate.

The advantage with this location is its proximity to the studio. If the weather forecast is looking unsettled it allows for a quick change to indoors should it start to rain partway through your photoshoot. It also gives us the option to split a full length (1 hour) session into two parts (half studio / half outdoors) for two completely different vibes.

This secluded spot is my best kept secret!  
Featuring a grassy area, trees and an attractive fence line, it has everything required for an outdoor photoshoot - all just around the corner from the studio.



## Getting There



Enter Wern Trading Estate from Chartist Drive and then take the first turning on your left.

Pass Ballet Cymru and continue to follow the road around in a 'U' shape. When you arrive at the end of the road you'll find a grassy area right in front of you.

On-Road parking available.

## Meet & Greet

Although this area is only an 8 minute walk from the studio, to maximise your photoshoot time, I'll usually ask you to go directly there instead of meeting at the studio first. For the same reason, I also recommend driving between the studio and our outdoor spot if we're splitting a full length session.

## 20 minute Mini Sessions

We'll focus our 20 minutes on a variety of shots among the trees, on the grass and along the fence line.

## Full Length Sessions (1 hour)

A full hour gives us extra time to spend setting up additional posed photographs and to take in some action shots too.

However, the main benefit is on those occasions when the weather forecast is very uncertain. This location gives us the flexibility to abandon our outdoor plans and move into the studio if it starts to rain partway through your booking.

If you're undecided on whether you'd prefer an outdoor or a studio session, this venue also offers you the best of both worlds. You can choose to split your session by spending the first half an hour in the studio, and then relocating outdoors for the second half of your photoshoot.
